

# Paschimi Singhbhum District Profile



*Paschimi Singhbhum district ranks eighth in terms of total population in the state and ranks seventeenth in regard to decadal population growth rate (2001-11) among the twenty-four district. With a sex ratio of 1005, it ranks first in the state. The district comprise of eighteen blocks namely, Sonua, Gudri, Bandhgaon, Chakradharpur, Khuntpani, Goelker, Anandpur, Manoharpur, Noamundi, Tonto, Hat Gamharia, Chaibasa, Tantnagar, Manjhari, Jhinkpani, Jagannathpur, Kumardungi and Manjhgaon. As per Census 2011, the district has 1642 villages and 11 towns distributed in five assembly constituencies. Census 2011 figures indicated that the percentage share of scheduled caste population to total population was 3.79 percent while that of scheduled tribes was 67.31 percent. Based on the number of total rural households in Census 2011 and BPL Revision Survey of 2010-11 the percentage of BPL households in rural areas is 65.72 percent.*
